

#### **BUILD A BRIDGE**




Count 4 yellow connectors and 6 pink straws




2 Count 4 green connectors and 2 yellow straws




### **MAKE A SWING**


Count 2 blue connectors, 2 yellow connectors, 2 green straws and 1 yellow straws




2 Count 2 green connectors and 1 green straw




**3** Count 4 green connectors and 4 blue straws

Count 2 red connectors and 3 yellow straws




2 Count 2 red connectors and 2 yellow straws

4 Cut the uniform from back of booklet




Draw the uniform of one of the town protectors








1 Count 2 red connectors and 10 orange straws

Make 2 of these




3 Add 1 green connector on the top
