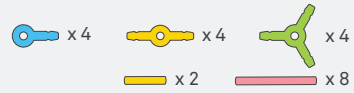

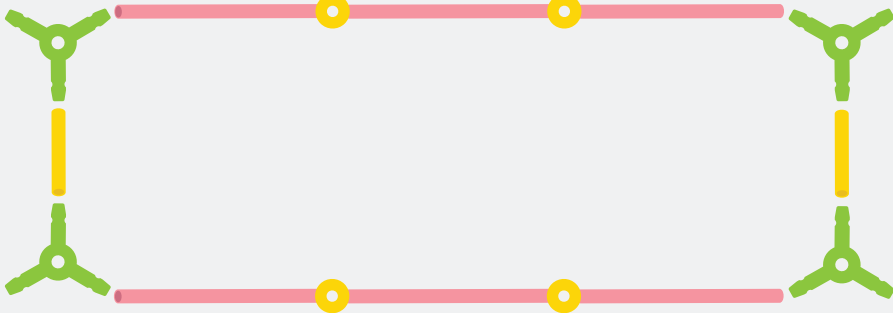


- 1** Count 4 yellow connectors and 6 pink straws

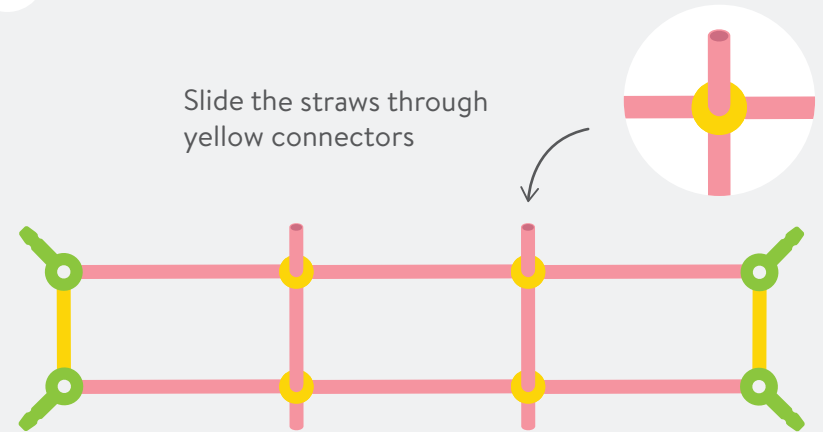


Make 2 beams

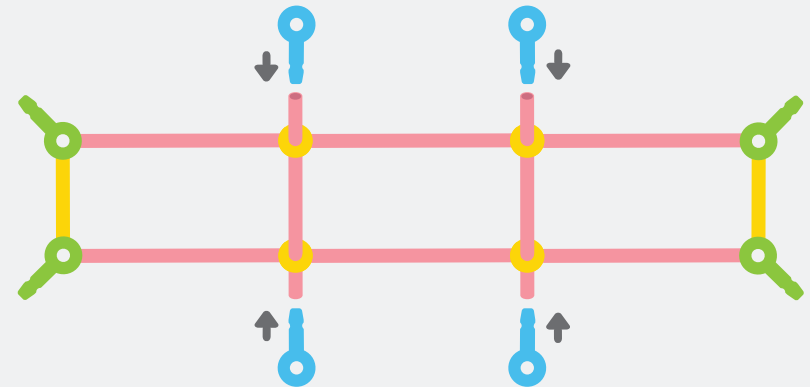
- 2** Count 4 green connectors and 2 yellow straws

- 5** Lay your bridge between 2 chairs and create a road from paper for cars to cross over!

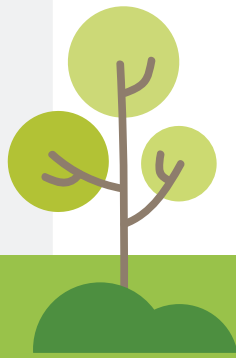

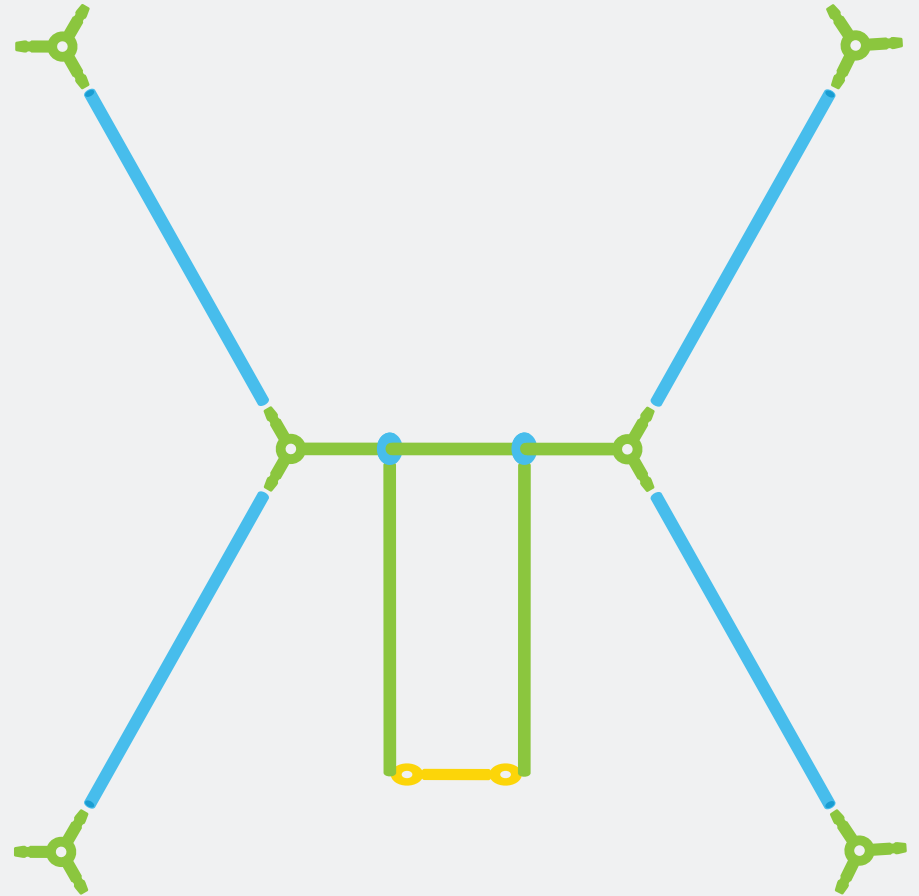
1 Count 2 blue connectors, 2 yellow connectors, 2 green straws and 1 yellow straws



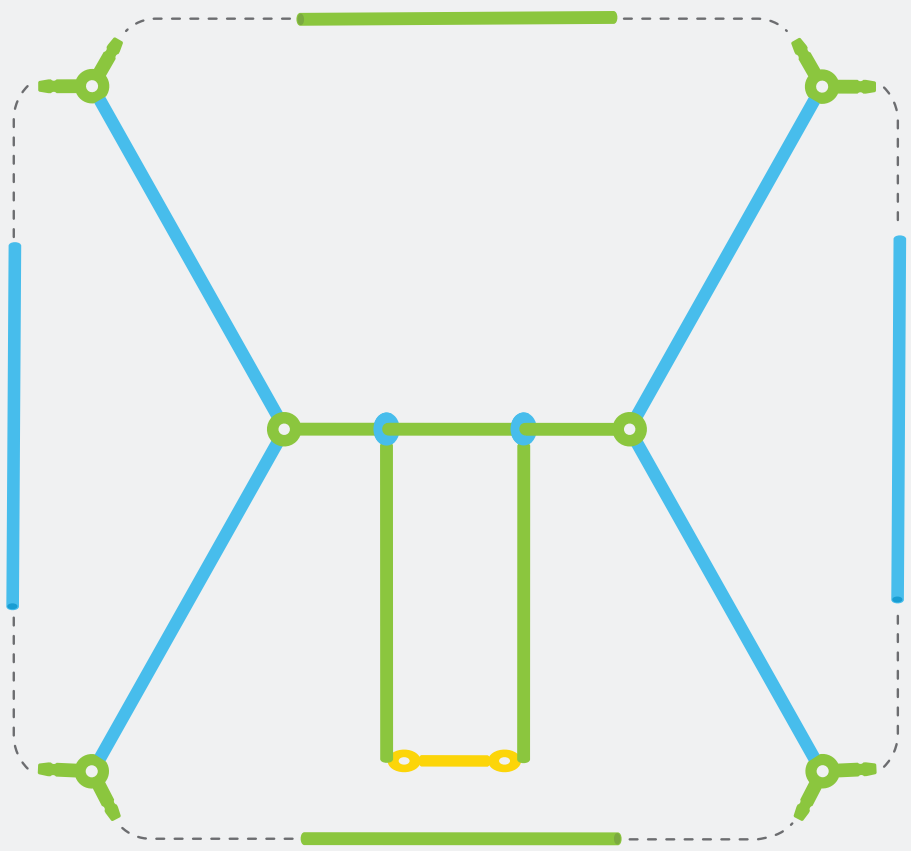
2 Count 2 green connectors and 1 green straw



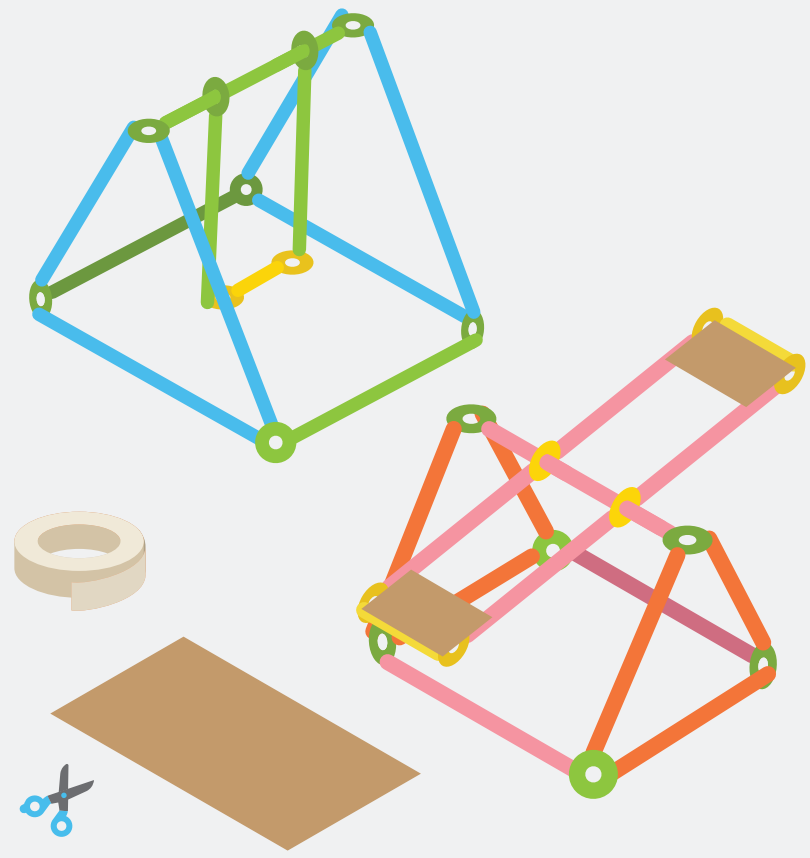
3 Count 4 green connectors and 4 blue straws

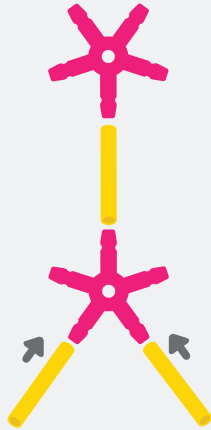

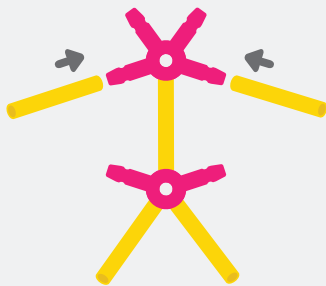

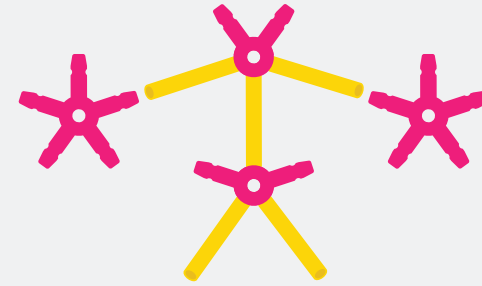
1 Count 2 red connectors and 3 yellow straws



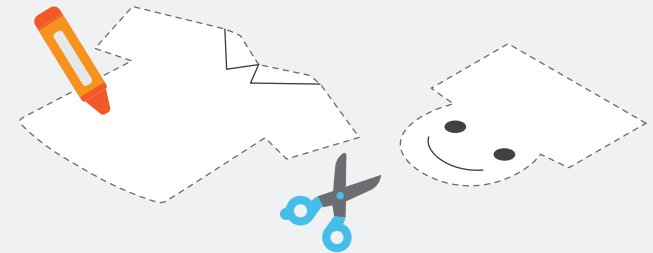
2 Count 2 red connectors and 2 yellow straws



3 Count 2 red connectors for hands

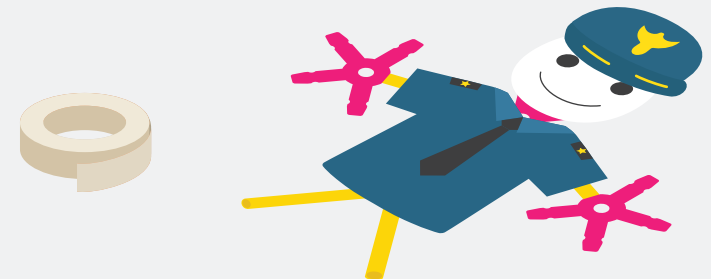


4 Cut the uniform from back of booklet

2 Count 5 yellow connectors

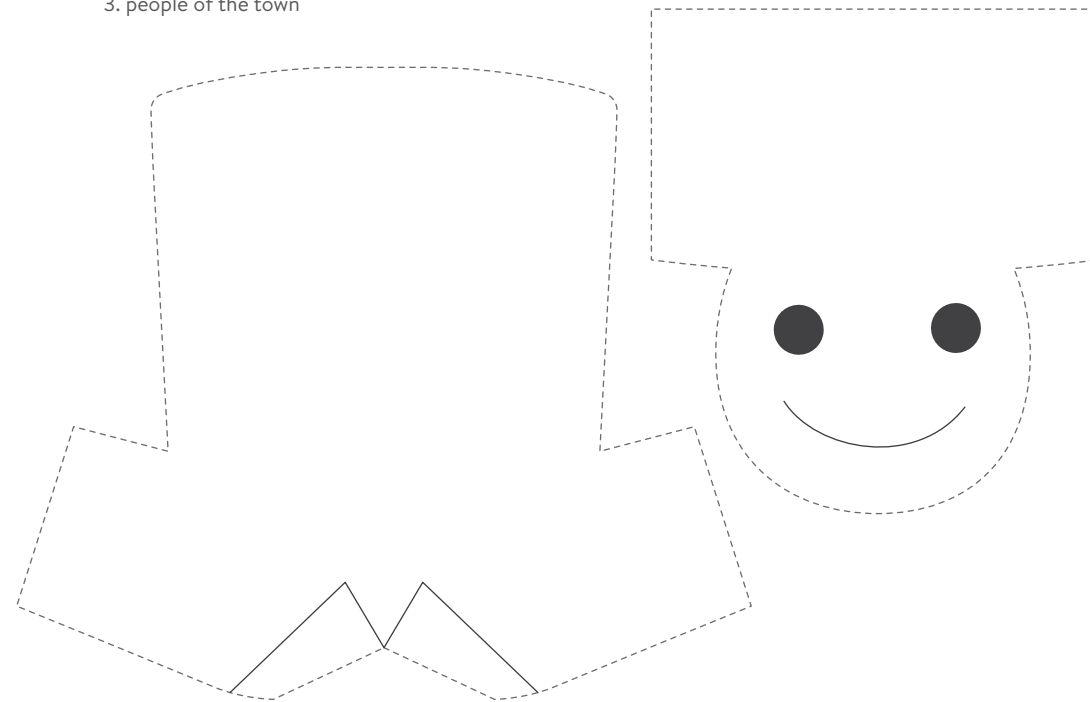


3 Add 1 green connector on the top
