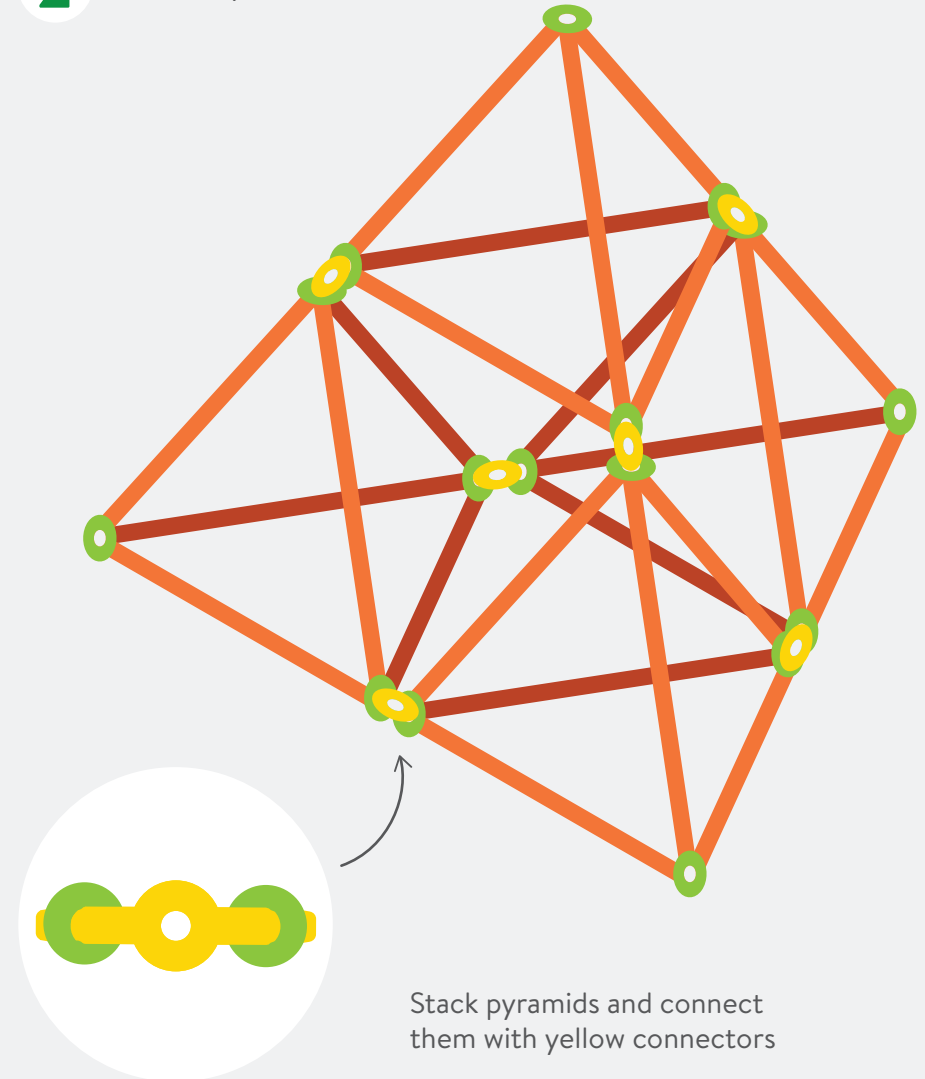

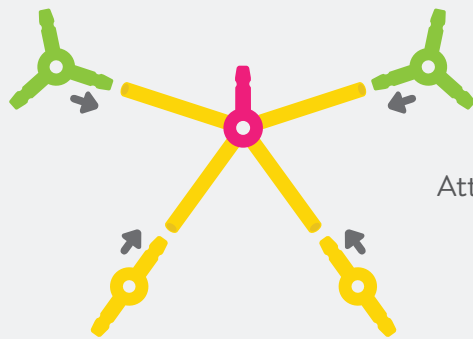
BUILD A MASK FOR THE CARNIVAL

2 Count 2 green connectors and 2 yellow connectors

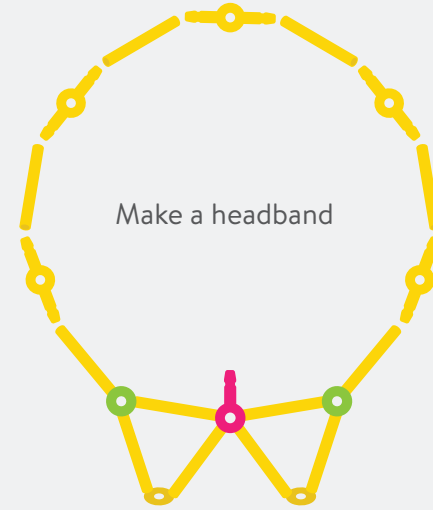

Attach straws to connectors for the mask

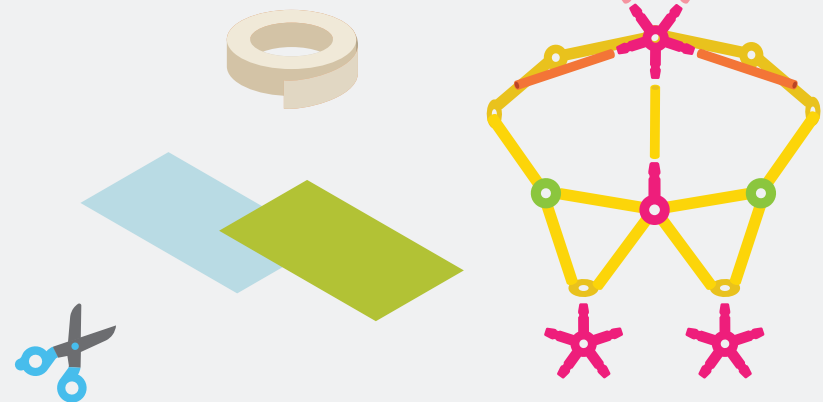


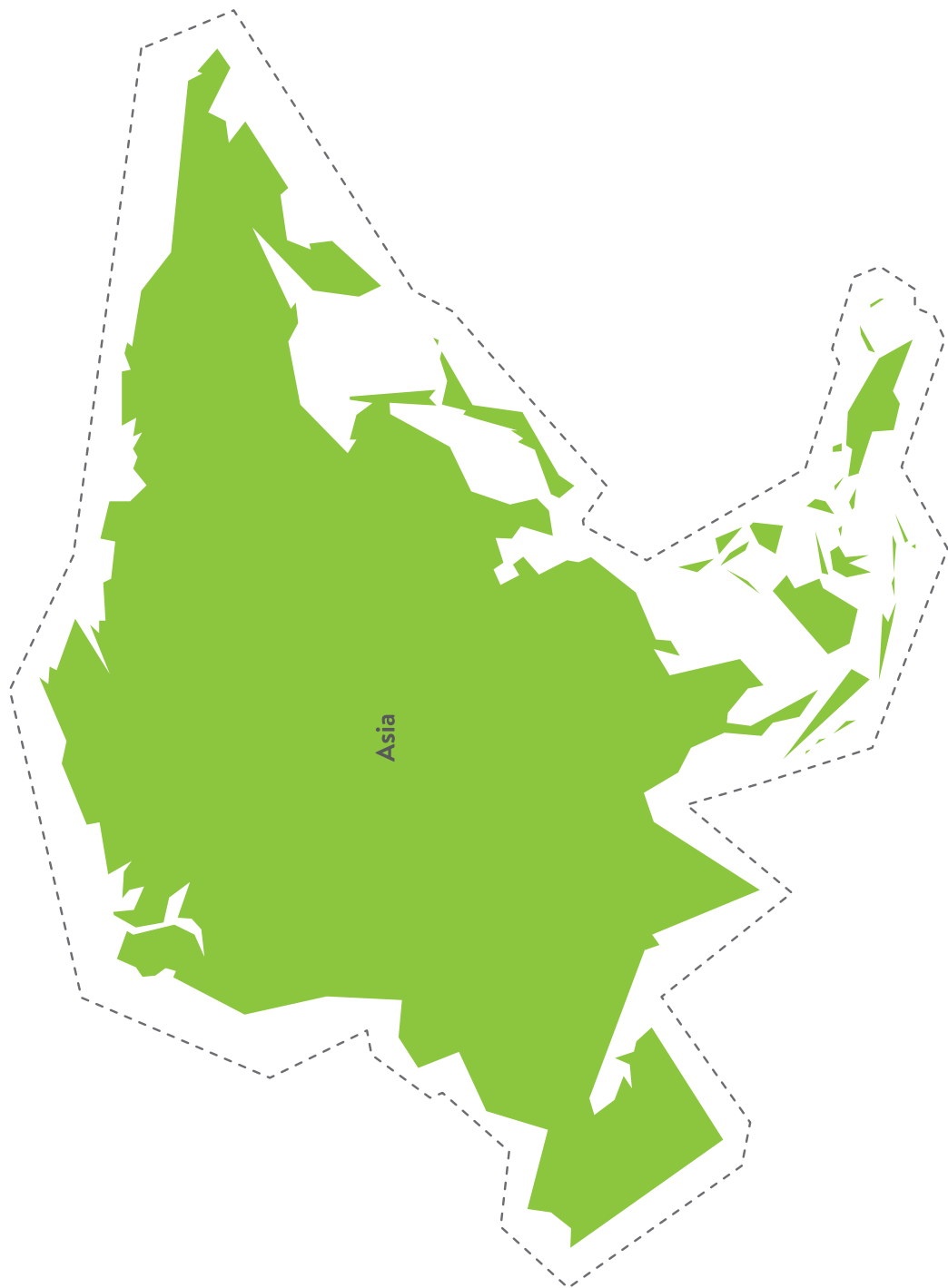
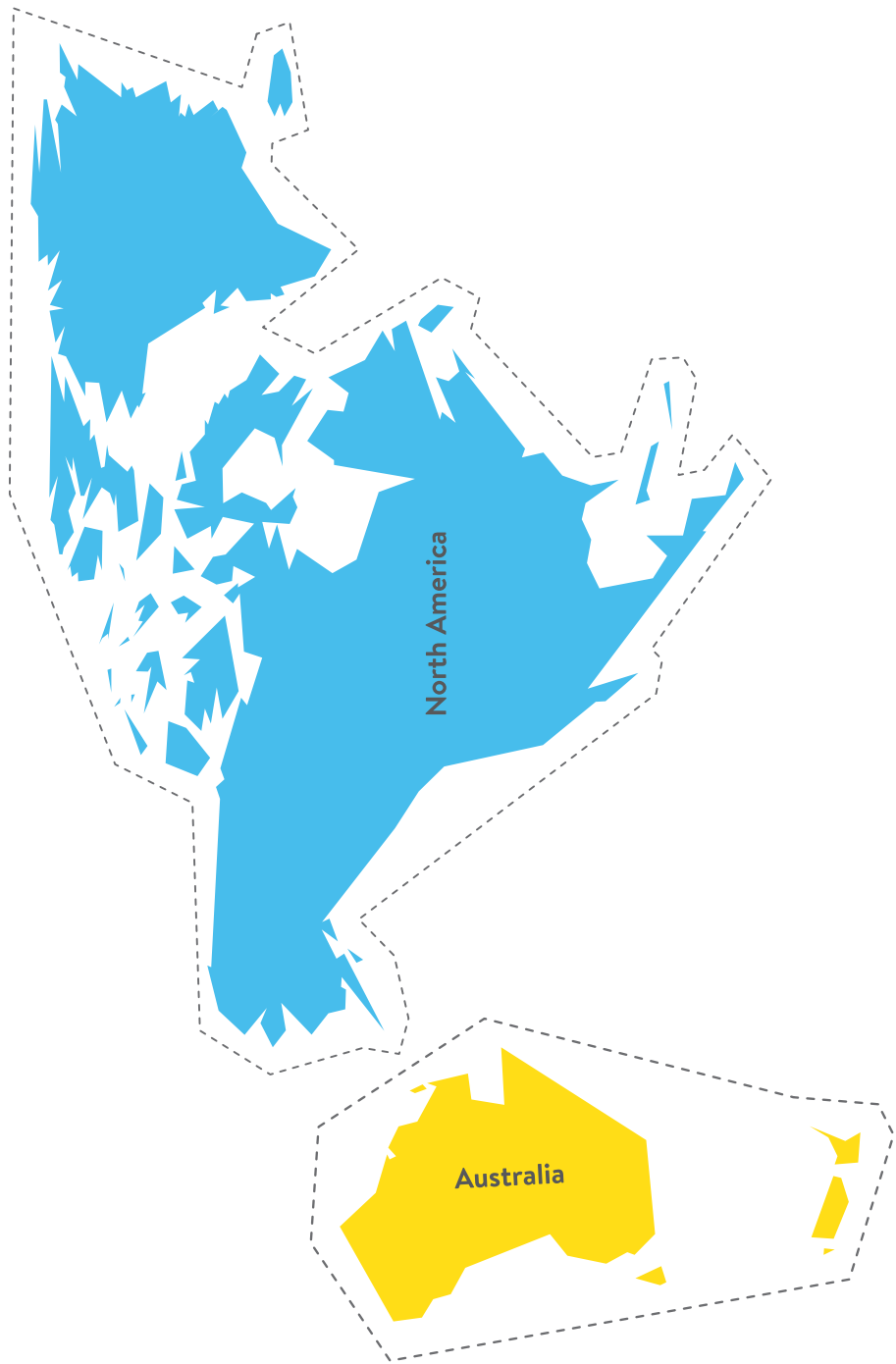
